



## New K12 Education Bills – 2016 Session February 26, 2016

### *Assessment and Accountability*

**AB 1850**            **Garcia E (D)**            **Educational Services Federal Immigration Reform**  
Relates to the federal immigration Reform and Control Act of 1986. Relates to a state test be used by eligible aliens to attest to their understanding of English and understanding of the history and government of the United State. Deletes the word illegal from related legislative findings.

**AB 1876**            **Lopez (D)**            **Pupils Diploma Alternatives Language Options**  
Prohibits the Department of Education from approving or renewing approval of a contractor or testing center to administer tests unless the contractor or testing center provides those tests in the top primary high school equivalency languages used in the contractor or testing center's services area. Requires an examinee to be able to tale the test in the offered language of his or her choice.

**AB 1935**            **Kim (R)**            **Local Control and Accountability Plans: Languages**  
Amends provisions of existing law that provides when a minimum percentage of pupils enrolled in a public schools speak a single primary language other than English, all reports, statements, or records sent to a parent or guardian shall be in their primary language. Requires multilingual notice requirements to apply to a local control and accountability plan or update or revision posted to the Internet Web site of a school district, a county office of education, or the Superintendent of Public Instruction.

**AB 1985**            **Williams (D)**            **Postsecondary Education**  
Requires the California Community Colleges to develop, and each community college district to adopt, a uniform policy to award a pupil who passes an Advanced Placement exam with a score of 3 or higher, credit for a course within this curriculum with subject matter similar to that of the Advanced Placement Exam.

**AB 2072**            **Chang (R)**            **High School Diplomas: STEM Seal**  
Expresses the Legislature's intent to enact legislation that would establish a State Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) Seal.

**Location:** ASSEMBLY

**AB 2259**            **Medina (D)**            **School Accountability: Dropout Recovery Highschool**  
Extends the repeal date of existing law, which requires the Superintendent of Public Instruction and the State Board of Education to allow no more than a certain number of dropout recovery high schools to report the results of an individual pupil growth model that is proposed by the school and certified by the Superintendent pursuant to specified criteria instead of reporting other indicators.

**AB 2306 Frazier (D) High School Graduation Requirements**

Requires a school district to exempt a pupil who, any time after the pupil completes 10th grade, transfers to the school district from a juvenile court school from all coursework and other requirements adopted by the governing board of the school district for high school graduation that are in addition to the statewide coursework requirements.

**AB 2350 O'Donnell (D) English Learners: English Language Proficiency**

Relates to school pupils who are English learners. Includes charter schools. Provides for the assessment and for the reclassification of a pupil from English learner to English proficient. Deletes English language development tests that are identified or acquired, but not developed, from tests that may be used by the assessment.

**AB 2443 Baker (R) Local Control and Accountability Plans**

Relates to control and accountability plan by the governing board of a school district. Requires a description of the annual goals to be achieved for each of the state's delineated priorities for all pupils and certain subgroups of pupils. Adds to those factors the number of practicing school psychologist working on school climate issues.

**AB 2527 Weber (D) School Accountability: Model Surveys**

Requires the Superintendent of Public Instruction to convene an advisory committee consisting of representatives from the state board, public schools, governing boards of school districts, local educational agencies, parent groups, parent and youth-serving community-based organizations, and advocacy organizations to provide general guidance on, and to make recommendations relating to the creation of model survey questions.

**AB 2548 Weber (D) School Accountability System**

Requires the State Board of Education to adopt a specified statewide accountability system. Authorizes the board to require local educational agencies to submit certain data in order to satisfy federal accountability system requirements.

**AB 2698 Weber (D) Local Control and Accountability Plans**

Makes nonsubstantive changes to existing law that requires the governing board of each school district to adopt a local control and accountability plan using a template adopted by the State Board of Education.

**SB 1145 Hueso (D) Language Arts: Reading: Assessments and Plans**

Requires the State Board of Education to develop a reading assessment that can be used by the public schools to assess certain pupils. Requires public schools that enroll pupils in certain grades, to ensure that each pupil's reading competency is measured using the assessment. Provides for certain reading

plans. Makes changes to the After School Education and Safety Program with regard to tutoring and homework assistance in language arts.

**SB 1156 Huff (R) School Accountability: Academic Performance Index**

Makes nonsubstantive changes to existing law which requires the Superintendent of Public Instruction, with approval of the State Board of Education, to develop an Academic Performance Index, to measure the performance of schools and school districts, especially the academic performance of pupils.

## ***Athletics***

**AB 1660 Cooper (D) Interscholastic Athletics: Interscholastic Federation**

Requires the Interscholastic Federation to report to the Legislature and the Governor on its evaluation and accountability activities undertaken pursuant to specified provisions.

**AB 2007 McCarty (D) Youth Athletics: Youth Sports Organizations: Injuries**

Amends existing law which requires a school district, charter school, or private school to remove an athlete from an athletic activity if the athlete is suspected of sustaining a concussion or head injury, and which requires a concussion and head injury information sheet to be signed and returned by the parent or guardian. Applies these provisions to athletes participating in youth sports organizations.

**AB 2182 Mullin (D) School Athletics: Neurocognitive Testing**

Requires a school district, charter school, or private school that offers an athletic program to provide neurocognitive testing for pupils who participate in interscholastic athletics. Requires this testing to take place at the beginning of an athletic season before any competitions have taken place and after any head injury.

**SB 1420 Mendoza (D) Inter-scholarship Athletics**

Makes nonsubstantive changes to existing law that provides that each school district governing board has general control of, and responsibility for, all aspects of the interscholastic athletic policies, programs, and activities in its district.

**SCR 101 Fuller (R) California Girls and Women in Sports Week**

Recognizes female athletes, coaches, officials, and sports administrators for their important contributions in promoting the value of sports in the achievement of full human potential and proclaims February 1 to 7, 2016, as California Girls and Women in Sports Week.

## **Career Technical Education**

### **AB 1835            Holden (D)            Private Postsecondary Education: Exemptions**

Exempts from the provisions of the Private Postsecondary Education Act of 2009 an institution solely offering terminal professional degrees under specified conditions.

### **AB 2063            Gallagher (R)            Work-Based Learning Opportunities**

Lowers the minimum age for participation in work experience education and the minimum age to receive credit for participation in a student apprenticeship program. Increases the number of hours a pupil is authorized to participate in a job shadowing experience.

### **AB 2097            Melendez (R)            Career Technical Education**

Makes a nonsubstantive change to existing law which authorizes, among other things, the governing board of any high school district to establish and maintain, in connection with any high school or regional occupational center or program under its jurisdiction, cooperative career technical education programs or community classrooms as part of a career technical education course.

### **AB 2288            Burke (D)            Apprenticeship Programs**

Requires the Workforce Development Board and each local board to ensure that preapprenticeship training the building and construction trades follows the Multi-Craft Core Curriculum developed by the California Department of Education and that programs and services funded by the federal Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014.

### **AB 2412            Chang (R)            Community Colleges: Career Technical Education**

Expresses the intent of the Legislature to enact legislation relating to workforce development and career technical education programs offered at campuses of the California Community Colleges.

### **AB 2642            Garcia E (D)            Removing Barriers to Employment Act**

Enacts the Removing Barriers to Employment Act, which would require the Workforce Investment Board to create a grant program to provide funds to local workforce investment boards and community-based organizations working in partnership on proposals that will address the needs of the persons who have multiple barriers to employment.

### **AB 2719            Garcia E (D)            Workforce Development: Out of School Youth**

Includes within the definition of an individual with employment barriers and out of school youth, would revise the duties of the Workforce Development Board regarding out of school youth. Defines local workforce development system stakeholders.

## **Charter Schools**

### **AB 1652 Waldron (R) Charter Schools: Renewal Period**

Provides that each of the first 2 charter school renewals shall be for a period of 5 years and subsequent renewals shall be for a period requested by the charter school not to exceed 15 years.

### **AB 2806 Wilk (R) School Districts: Los Angeles Unified School District**

Relates to Los Angeles Unified School District audits and investigations including administering oaths or affirmations. Prohibits the inspector general from auditing or investigating a charter school unless the audit or investigation is authorized by the governing board of the Los Angeles Unified School District. Relates to disclosure of information that was acquired pursuant to a subpoena.

### **SB 1434 Glazer (D) Charter Schools**

Authorizes a school district, county office of education, or charter school to file a grievance with the State Board of Education alleging a violation of an obligation of a chartering authority. Requires the state board's Advisory Commission on Charter Schools to hold a public hearing on the grievance. Relates to procedures regarding the approval or denial of a petition. Authorizes judicial review of a petition not timely acted upon. Relates to charter renewal procedures. Authorizes a countywide charter.

## **Child Nutrition/Food Safety**

### **AB 2054 Thurmond (D) Nutrition Assistance: Electronic Benefits Transfer**

Requires the Health and Human Services Agency to design and implement the Summer Electronic Benefits Transfer for Children (SEBTC) to provide nutrition assistance benefits to eligible households.

### **SB 970 Leyva (D) Organic Food Waste Diversion**

Requires the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery to develop a pilot program that encourages cost-effective and efficient integrated organic food waste diversion projects.

**Location:** Senate Environmental Quality Committee

### **SB 1169 McGuire (D) Pupil Nutrition: Competitive Food Service**

Relates to nutritional standards for all food and beverages other than meals reimbursed under programs authorized by the Richard B. Russell National School Lunch Act and the Child Nutrition Act of 1966. Requires every public school to inform the public about the content of the school's local school wellness policy and make the local school wellness policy and any updates to the policy available to the public on an annual basis.

### **SB 1211 Huff (R) Educational Programs**

Repeals existing law that required the Legislature to complete a specified study on specified matters relating to school breakfast programs.

## Credentialing

### **AB 1756            Bonilla (D)            Teacher Credentialing: Professional Preparation**

Amends existing law that establishes minimum requirements for the issuance of a preliminary multiple or single subject teaching credential by the Commission on Teacher Credentialing. Requires intensive field experiences to include student teaching.

### **AB 1918            O'Donnell (D)            Teacher Credentialing: Nonpublic, Nonsectarian Schools**

Authorizes a county or city and county board of education to issue temporary certificates to certified employees of nonpublic, nonsectarian schools whose credentials are being processed by the commission. Requires the state department of education to recognize all teacher permits, credentials, and certificates issued by the commission or a county or city and county board of education.

### **AB 2122            McCarty (D)            Classified School Employee Teacher Credential Program**

Revises provisions establishing the Classified School Employee Teacher Credentialing Program for the purpose of recruiting classified school employees to participate in a program designed to encourage them to enroll in teacher training programs and to provide instructional service as teachers in the public schools. Requires a solicitation for funding proposals to all school districts and county offices of education. Provides program participation criteria. Requires background checks.

### **AB 2124            Garcia E (D)            Teacher Credentialing: Career Technical Education**

Makes a nonsubstantive change to existing law which specifies the requirements for the 3-year preliminary designated subjects career technical education teaching credential.

### **AB 2248            Holden (D)            Teacher Credentialing**

Requires the Commission on Teacher Credentialing to issue certain teaching credentials within a certain number of days of receiving all required documentation. Provides for authorization for a teacher to provide specific services to limited English proficient pupils.

### **AB 2336            Olsen (R)            Teacher Credentialing: Emergency Substitute Permit**

Requires the Commission on Teacher Credentialing to issue Emergency Substitute Teaching Permits authorizing the holder to substitute teach, limited each school year to up to 60 days for any one teacher in a general education classroom or 40 days for any one teacher in a special education classroom.

### **AB 2706            Wilk (R)            Teachers: Credentialing**

Makes nonsubstantive changes to existing law that requires the Commission on Teacher Credentialing to issue a 5-year preliminary multiple subject teaching credential that meets specified requirements, including that the teacher possess a baccalaureate degree from a regionally accredited institution of higher education.

**AB 2815 O'Donnell (D) Teacher Credentialing: Alternative Programs**

Requires alternative teacher programs to address the shortage area of special education.

**SB 916 Allen (D) Teacher Credentialing**

Adds dance and theatre to the list of authorized subjects that the Commission on Teacher Credentialing may issue a single subject teaching credential. Provides that a person issued a single subject teaching credential in physical education or English before the establishment of a single subject teaching credential in dance or theatre, respectively, is authorized to teach in dance or theatre.

## ***Curriculum and Instruction***

**AB 1689 Low (D) School Curriculum: Coursework for High School**

Requires, for each high school class graduating in each subsequent school year, at least one of the courses completed by a pupil to satisfy the graduation requirements referenced in existing law to have a service learning component. Defines service learning for this purpose. Requires the development of curriculum standards that incorporate a service learning component. Requires, if such standards are adopted, that school districts implement them as a component of courses to meet graduation requirements.

**AB 1719 Rodriguez (D) Pupil Instruction: Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation**

Requires the governing board of a school district, and the governing body of a charter school, offering instruction to pupils in grades 9 to 12, inclusive, to provide instruction on performing cardiopulmonary resuscitation and the use of an automated external defibrillator as part of a course required for graduation.

**AB 1846 Lopez (D) Adult Education Consortium Program**

Appropriates a specified amount of funds every fiscal year from the General Fund to the Community Colleges and the State Department of Education for ongoing support of the adult education consortium program.

**AB 1873 Holden (D) High School Graduation: Mathematics: Completion**

Makes nonsubstantive changes to existing law that authorizes the governing board of a school district that requires the completion of courses in the mathematics for graduation from high school to award a pupil up to one mathematics course credit for successfully completing an approved computer science course.

**AB 2016 Alejo (D) Pupil Instruction: Ethnic Studies**

Requires the Superintendent of Public Instruction to oversee the development of, and the State Board of Education to adopt, a model curriculum to ensure quality courses in ethnic studies. Requires each school district that does not otherwise offer a standards-based ethnic studies curriculum, to offer a course of study in ethnic studies based on the model curriculum.

**AB 2237**            **Olsen (R)**                    **Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math Education**  
Expresses the intent of the Legislature to enact legislation relating to the provision of science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) education in elementary and secondary schools in the state.

**AB 2290**            **Santiago (D)**                    **Pupil Instruction**  
Makes a nonsubstantive change to existing law which sets forth the intent and purpose of the Legislature to encourage the establishment of programs of instruction in foreign language.

**Location:** ASSEMBLY

**AB 2322**            **Chu (D)**                            **Vehicles: Instruction Permits: Decals**  
Requires the Department of Motor Vehicles to provide the recipient of an instruction permit with a removable and transferable decal that reads student driver. Authorizes the holder of the instruction permit to affix the decal to the rear or side window of the vehicle when operating the vehicle.

**AB 2329**            **Bonilla (D)**                    **Computer Science Curriculum: Study**  
Requests that the Council on Science and Technology undertake and complete a study to understand the needs to advance computer science in high school curriculum and to move forward with policy that increases computer science education opportunities in high school.

**AB 2684**            **Dababneh (D)**                    **Financial Literacy**  
Makes a nonsubstantive, technical change regarding the existing law establishes California Financial Literacy Fund, to be administered by the Controller, for the purpose of enabling partnerships with financial services community and governmental and nongovernmental stakeholders to improve Californians' financial literacy.

**AB 2838**            **O'Donnell (D)**                    **Public Elementary and Secondary Education**  
Expresses the intent of the Legislature to enact legislation relating to public elementary and secondary education.

**AB 2864**            **Chau (D)**                            **Pupil Instruction: Chinese Exclusion Act**  
Encourages all state and local professional development activities to provide teachers with content background and resources to assist them in teaching about the Chinese Exclusion Act of 1882, the Gear Act of 1892, and other specified laws relating to the discrimination against, and mistreatment of, Chinese and other minority groups.

**ACR 133**            **Chang (R)**                            **Women and Girls in STEM Week**  
Designates April 3, 2016, to April 9, 2016, as Women and Girls in STEM Week.

- SB 911**                    **Hertzberg (D)**                    **California American Indian Education Centers**  
 Deletes the repeal date thereby extending existing law establishing a California American Indian education center by any tribal group or incorporated American Indian association to meet specified objectives and providing for the administration of grants by the State department of Education for those purposes in accordance with specified provisions.

- SB 1050**                    **De Leon (D)**                    **Elementary and Secondary Education: Achievement Gap**  
 States the intent of the Legislature to enact legislation that would close the achievement gap, ensure an adequate supply of well-trained teachers, expand access to quality support services, and ensure access for all pupils to a rich course of study in both academic and career-related subjects.

- SB 1123**                    **Leyva (D)**                    **Pupil Instruction: High School Graduation Requirements**  
 Requires, as a condition of receiving a diploma of graduation from high school, that the coursework requirements include, among others, the completion of one course in visual or performing arts, foreign language, or career technical education.

- SB 1296**                    **Liu (D)**                    **Pupil Instruction: Financial Literacy**  
 Requires consumer and homemaking education to include financial literacy instruction on subjects including, but not limited to, student loans, credit cards, and investment and retirement accounts.

- SB 1356**                    **Allen (D)**                    **Instruction Materials**  
 Makes a nonsubstantive change to existing law that requires the State Board of Education to consider the adoption of a revised curriculum framework and evaluation criteria for instructional materials in science.

- SB 1435**                    **Jackson (D)**                    **School Curriculum**  
 Requires the Instructional Quality Commission to include comprehensive information during the next revision, and to include comprehensive information, for grades 1 to 8, inclusive, on the development of healthy relationships.

- SB 1457**                    **Morrell (R)**                    **Pupil Instruction: Graduation Requirements**  
 Authorizes a school district board to adopt a policy to allow a high school pupil to earn elective credits toward high school graduation requirements for the completion of released time instruction. Requires a decision to award credit for released time instruction to be neutral to, and not involve any test for, religious content or denominational affiliation. Requires the policy to include secular criteria for determining earning credit. Requires such absence not be used to compute average daily attendance.

## ***Employee Evaluation and Training***

### **AB 2200 Thurmond (D) Teachers: Recruitment and Retention**

States the intent of the Legislature to enact legislation that would guarantee that every pupil has access to high-quality educators by ensuring that pupils' educators are able to live in the communities in which they serve.
