- Evaluate the effectiveness of Tier 1 and Tier 2 practices
- Facilitate identification of and the process of implementing any adjustments that need to be made to Tier 3 practices
- Determine eligibility for additional resources and evaluation of individual education programs
- Determine sufficiency of implementation integrity
- Learn how to administer and determine best data tracking tools
- Develop a flow chart of behavior interventions
